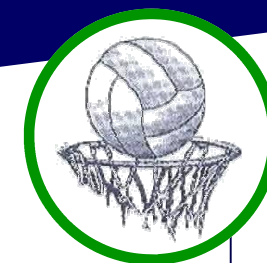

Expected Player Costs - (These are estimates and may change throughout the season)

\$100	NTNA Registration	Paid entirely to the Netball Association and covers your insurance for the season. This money must be paid prior to you taking the court, no exceptions.
\$10	Uniform/Dress	We have brand new dresses for the 2011 season. \$50 is required to order the dress and balance is required on collection.
\$70 - \$80	Court Fees	This is the charge for hiring the courts at the Silverdome for which the association passes onto the players. This will be charged to you towards the end of the season but will be reduced depending on how much fundraising you help with throughout the season. It could possibly be \$0!!
\$10 - \$20	Gym Hire	This will be charged with your court fees and helps the club pay for an indoor training venue.
\$?	Training Uniforms	We normally order clothes like polo tops, jumpers or this year Clovers drink bottles, these items are not compulsory to buy, it's totally up to you.
\$20 - \$30	Umpire Payments	Depending on if we find people that are willing to umpire for us. Players would be asked to contribute towards paying umpires. Or pay nothing if you would prefer to umpire yourself.

NTNA Registration

NTNA 2010 senior (adult) registration is \$100, this money is paid directly to the association and covers your insurance for the season. The registration form and money must be given to the club prior to you taking the court for your first game, and is non negotiable.

Umpiring

It is requested that all players attend the Level 1 umpires course provided by the NTNA. For those of you that haven't played netball for some time, it's a great way to brush up on all the rules. It is also important that you understand umpire language and signals in order to play the game. If you are interested in umpiring you will be paid for each game you umpire, please see our umpire coordinator for more information.

LMS - Last Man Standing

Last Man Standing is our major fundraiser for the year. It is based on a reverse raffle and we sell tickets for approximately \$20 each. The tickets are pulled out one by one until only one ticket remains. The last ticket wins the major prize, and in past it has been \$600 cash. We generally make a night of it with dancing, drinking and an all round general party.

Players Trip

With the season over it's great to have a weekend trip away with all our friends. We hire a bus and head to Bridport, where the games begin. And like any trip, what goes on a players trip, stays on a players trip. So to find out more, you'll have to come along!!!!!!

Footy Gate

The past few years we have been given the opportunity to man the gate at home games for St Pats Football Club. We run a raffle and the money goes towards our fundraising efforts. Players are asked to help with an hour or two of their time throughout the season and in return this reduces your court fees.
